

Update 20 March 2020
A Further Message regarding
Covid-19



Dear Member

Following review by the Management Board the following revisions to the conditions outlined in the notice dated 16th March will apply commencing Saturday, 21st March 2020:

1. Members will no longer be required to book use of the putting/chipping green through the tee booking system (BRS). Instead they are asked to check in with the Caddymaster who will enter the names in a record book.
2. Golf Buggies (for approved users) permitted – one person occupancy and sanitised after use.
3. Avoid congregating at 1st tee or anywhere else on the golf course.
4. Social & Tennis members are permitted to book tee times (from 2 days in advance) on a green fee basis before 10.00am and after 2.00pm Monday to Friday and after 4.00pm on Saturday & Sunday.
5. Professional Shop to open 8.00am to 6.00pm observing social distancing guidelines and payment by card 'tap' facility.
6. Golf Professional permitted to conduct coaching on a 'one on one' basis.
7. Tennis Professional permitted to conduct coaching on a 'one on one' basis.

The Club cannot guarantee supply of sanitisers due to worldwide supply limitations. It is your own personal responsibility to ensure you follow HSE guidelines to protect yourself and others against the spread of this virus.

The Management Board will keep this matter under ongoing review and will update you as required via email or on the Website. Office email and phone will be monitored.

We ask any member diagnosed, symptomatic or, who has returned from one of the affected regions not to attend the Club until they are medically cleared. If a member is diagnosed with this Coronavirus or has been in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed we would ask you to advise our Caretaker General Manager on generalmanager@elmpark.ie or 01 269 3438 as soon as possible. In line with HSE Guidelines the Club will not name any member or staff member who may become infected and we would ask all members and staff to respect people's privacy over the coming period.
